





Located in the Southwest of England, Bristol and Bath are linked by the River Avon and are only an 11-minute train journey apart. The two cities lie in one of the most beautiful parts of the country, an area rich in history and culture, fast becoming a hub for growing businesses and innovation. Both cities have their own distinctive feel yet perfectly complement each other and with Bristol Airport close by and faster train links to London, the region is now a major gateway, with easy access from the rest of the UK and the world.

Home to Banksy's world-class street art and with the accolades of 'World's best culinary destination' and UNESCO City of Film, Bristol is renowned for its vibrant arts and culture scene. The city buzzes all year round from an outstanding range of independent restaurants, bars, pubs and cafés and an annual programme of events in an eclectic mix of venues and outdoor spaces, including Upfest - Europe's largest street art festival and the spectacular Bristol International Balloon Fiesta. With iconic sights including Brunel's Clifton Suspension Bridge and the historic SS Great Britain on the harbourside, Bristol's reputation for pioneering engineering and innovation is as relevant today as it has always been. Bristol is the only UK city to be named European Green Capital (2015) and was the UK's first cycling city. As one of the UK's leading cities for sustainable development it is home to leading environmental and ethical organisations such as the Soil Association, Triodos Bank and Sustrans.





Blending historic charm with cutting-edge technology, Bath is a business-ready city with a truly stunning backdrop. Built for pleasure and relaxation, beautiful Bath has been a wellbeing destination since Roman times. Strolling through the streets you will be surrounded by stunning honey-coloured stone and Georgian architecture - highlights include the iconic Royal Crescent and the majestic Circus. The waters are still a big draw, both at the ancient Roman Baths and the thoroughly modern Thermae Bath Spa, which houses the only natural thermal hot springs in Britain you can bathe in. As the only city in the UK designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Bath has many green spaces and parks to enjoy. The city also has a reputation for elite sports, with Bath University Sports Training Village hosting international teams in preparation for events in the UK.

The two cities are surrounded by the stunning countryside of the Mendips and Cotswolds, and the north Somerset coastline. The coastal towns of Weston-super-Mare and Clevedon, together with the historic market towns offer unique experiences, while being close to significant transport networks, providing easy access to the UK and beyond.

BRISTOL INCREASES CONFERENCE AND EVENT CAPACITY WITH MAJOR VENUE EXPANSIONS AND DEVELOPMENTS

The Bristol area is set to significantly increase its capacity for large scale conferences, exhibitions and events following the announcement of three major developments in the city, with phased competitions between 2023 and 2026. Meet Bristol and Bath, the official Convention Bureau for Bristol, Bath and the surrounding region, anticipates that these increased capacities will put Bristol alongside destinations such as, Glasgow and Manchester for delegate capacity.

- In North Bristol, the YTL Arena Bristol will be the largest indoor arena and exhibition centre in the South. With a total 19000 capacity, the East Hangar will offer 6000sqm of pillar free floorspace and a 20m ceiling height, perfect for exhibitions and conferences. This is set to open in late 2025 / early 2026.
- Bristol Beacon will reopen on 30th November 2023 following a five-year transformation project. The refurbished music venue in the centre of Bristol has seen improvements to its spaces, with the 2000-plus capacity Beacon Hall, the 500 capacity Lantern Hall and the new 200 capacity Weston Cellar.
- The new Ashton Gate Sports and Convention Centre will sit alongside the current stadium with 4000m2 floorspace and a 232-room hotel, with work expected to start later this summer. The development will bring the Bristol Flyers Basketball team to the heart of BS3, alongside Bristol City and Bristol Bears, and will enable Ashton Gate to build on its success as a sports, entertainment and business events venue.






